James is an author and illustrator. He grew up in a tiny Suffolk village with his parents and big sister Kate. Art was his favourite subject at school and he knew that he would be an artist of some kind when he grew up. There was always a love of telling stories and reading in his family, even before he could read, Kate would tell him stories. His first book, *Katie's Picture Show*, published in 1989, was inspired by a trip to London with his sister and Grandma. There are many more '*Katie'* titles, introducing the great works of art to children. He also has written and illustrated a series *Ella Bella Ballerina*. As well as making books on his own, he also illustrates for many other authors. This includes *Mrs Noah's Pockets*, longlisted for the Kate Greenaway Award in 2019 and more recently *Nen and the Lonely Fisherman* and *Mrs Noah's Song* published July 2022. When he isn't making books, he is painting to music, creating art during performances of spectacular classical masterpieces and is an adviser to Action for Children's Arts, a charity that campaigns for children's right to access the arts.
