



Teachers' Summer Reading Challenge 2019

Take the challenge and join your pupils this summer by reading 6 children's books. This is a great opportunity to:

- Refresh your knowledge of children's books
- Read your key texts
- Experiment with new authors/illustrators
- Broaden your knowledge of poetry/non fiction writers
- Discover picture books for every primary age
- CPD

How to participate:

- Borrow the books. This can be done in a variety of ways:
 1. Visit one of the SLS centres based at: Calmore Junior School (term time only); Fareham Public Library; Farnborough Public Library and South Ham Public Library. It is essential to book an appointment – please contact hq.sls@hants.gov.uk if you do not have the relevant details
 2. Ask the SLS staff to send a selection of titles via the education courier.
 3. Consider using the SLS ebooks and audiobooks. If your school has signed up to use these resources, you can access these from anywhere
 4. Use any public library. If you are not a member why not join? You can do this online at <https://www.hants.gov.uk/librariesandarchives/library>
- If you would like help selecting or would like some inspiration, please do use the SLS booklists found on the SLS Moodle
- Once you have read the books please visit the SLS Moodle home page <https://sls.hias.hants.gov.uk/> and follow the link to complete a brief book review for each title
- When you have completed all 6 books visit the SLS Moodle and print off a certificate to celebrate your achievement. Please do display this in your classroom for all your pupils to see!

The challenge will run at the same time as the public library Summer Reading Challenge:

5th July until 13th September.
